Your custom piece will be entirely crafted by hand using heavy gauge sterling silver. Design will be at the artists' discretion. Stone: just under 1 1/4" long x just under 1" wide.*

### About the Artists

Tamara has been cutting stones for over five years. A love of rock hounding and collecting stones one day led to the obvious question: what do I do with all these rocks? The result was to learn how to both carve by hand and cut cabochons using a cabbing machine. Tamara likes to specialize in exotic and unusual elements such as dinosaur bone, lace agate, fire agate, rhyolite and more. Naturally, turquoise is another interest, and a few select stones have been cut with more in the works. You will find her creations in our showroom, usually set in exquisite pieces by Alton Bedonie.

Alton Bedonie is an award-winning Navajo artist who has been making jewelry since 1972. He and his wife Lillian live in Winslow Arizona. Alton blends both traditional influences with bold, contemporary designs to create jewelry that complements any ensemble, dressy or casual. We often collaborate with Alton on creating new and exciting designs that incorporate stones Tamara has cut.
